CALLING PORTLAND / MULTNOMAH COUNTY 911

Call 911 to report a serious injury, a fire, or a crime in progress. When you call 911, know your location, stay on the line, answer all questions, and follow instructions. If you are hearing impaired or in immediate danger, you can text to 911. Don't assume that 911 will automatically know your location, stay on the line and don't hang up until you are told to, and call back if you get disconnected. 911 calls made from a landline automatically advance to the 911 queue, and operators receive the phone number and physical location of where the call is being made from. 911 calls from cellular phones provide the phone number and a general location of where the call is coming from (within 50-300 meters), and are directed to an XMU system to confirm the validity of the 911 call.
