
PROPOSED ALL-NIGHT BUS ROUTE TO PDX AIRPORT

Since Portland International Airport is one of the busiest destinations in the region, as well as a location that people need day and night transportation to, Tri-Met has proposed a new bus route that would serve the airport during times when the Max Red Line isn't in service. The new route would connect to Burnside Street via 82^{nd} Avenue, where riders could transfer to proposed overnight service on line 20; all stops on 82^{nd} Avenue between Burnside and Killingsworth will be served.
