DO bring: Bulky items, appliances, furniture, mattresses, and household junk.

GLENHAVEN PARK REHABILITATION PROJECT

Glenhaven Park has some of the oldest play equipment in the parks system, dating back to the 1970's, and several play pieces were removed recently due to lead paint. A new playground, ADA pathway improvements, and public art are coming to Glenhaven Park, thanks to funding from the Parks Replacement Bond passed in 2014 (<https://www.portlandoregon.gov/parks/65128>) and a contribution from System Development Charges (<https://www.portlandoregon.gov/parks/38516>). You can give feedback on the final draft design at the CLTB New Year in the Park Celebration on April 28th, at Glenhaven Park. Construction is slated to begin Summer 2019. - **PROPOSED ALL-NIGHT BUS ROUTE TO PDX AIRPORT**

Since Portland International Airport is one of the busiest destinations in the region, as well as a location that people need day and night transportation to, Tri-Met has proposed a new bus route that would serve the airport during times when the Max Red Line isn't in service. The new route would connect to Burnside Street via 82nd Avenue, where riders could transfer to proposed overnight service on line 20; all stops on 82nd Avenue between Burnside and Killingsworth will be served.

- **CALLING PORTLAND / MULTNOMAH COUNTY 9-1-1**

Call 9-1-1 to report a serious injury, a fire, or a crime in progress. Know your location, answer all questions, and follow instructions. For the hearing impaired or those in immediate danger, you may text to 9-1-1 in Multnomah county. Stay on the line and don't hang up until you are told to; call back if you get disconnected.
